APLS Committees are listed below. While the charge of each committee is set by the Board of Directors and changes each year, the basic requirements of the committees are included. Please use this form to indicate your interest in serving on a particular committee.

- ACEC LIAISON** – Liaison is an individual who serves by facilitating communication between APLS and ACEC.
- BTR LIAISON** – Liaison is an individual who serves by facilitating communication between APLS and the Board of Technical Registration.
- BYLAWS COMMITTEE** – Committee members will review and draft bylaw amendments at the request of the Board and review chapter bylaws for conformity with the state.
- CONFERENCE** – Committee members will identify programs for the annual conference, set conference policies, and assist the Executive Office with the implementation of the Conference.
- EDUCATION** - Committee members will research and provide recommendations to the Board of Directors regarding seminars and education opportunities that would provide value to the membership.
- ETHICS & STANDARDS** - Committee members will, at the request of the Board of Directors, review and provide recommendations to the Board of Directors concerning minimum standards, continuing education, peer review and other practice standards.
- LEGISLATIVE** - Committee members will track legislation affecting the surveying profession and recommend positions (support, oppose, watch, etc.) to the Board of Directors for action. Committee will also solicit from members throughout the state, the need for potential legislation and report to the Board of Directors for consideration.
- MEMBERSHIP** – Committee members identify potential member benefits, man the membership booth at the APLS Conference, and perform such other duties as requested by the Board.
- PUBLIC INFORMATION** – Committee members will review, create and distribute documentation to inform the public about Arizona Professional Land Surveyors. They will also serve as editors of The Arizona Surveyor Magazine.
